However, in light of the recommendation by state of California and the sharp rise of positive cases and deaths, the church has voluntarily decided to take the following measures.

All public worships (Sunday, Saturday morning worship), Education Department, Korean Young Adults, and HolyWave will transition to online platform until March 29<sup>th</sup>. In addition, training classes, oikoses and all other ministries will transition to the online platform. Here are the full details.

First, Sa-Rang Community Church of Southern California will not cease worshipping.

We will hold all worships (Sunday, Saturday morning, education department, HolyWave, Korean Young Adults) online via live stream until March 29<sup>th</sup>. Online worship is to be held with the family wholeheartedly, with respectful attire and with online giving. Please be a model to your children by first participating in your own worship and then worshipping with your children through their respective ministry's online channel. Second, Sa-Rang Community Church of Southern California will not cease training.

Until March 31<sup>st</sup>, Discipleship Training will continue as well as possible through the online platform. Oikos leaders' meetings will continue as well through the online platform. However, missions training will be on a pause until further notice.

Third, Sa-Rang Community Church of Southern California will not cease shepherding.

Oikoses will continue to gather through the online platform to share in discussion and prayer. The leaders will be prepared to hold online Oikos. If you are having health issues or have been quarantined as a result of the effects of COVID-19, please let your leaders or pastors know and the pastoral staff will contact you to pray with you and provide counseling if necessary.

Fourth, Sa-Rang Community Church of Southern California will not cease praying.

Please set aside a time of prayer to pray for our church, the churches around the globe and for the boldness of Christ's body. Let us use this season to pray as the people of God. Lastly, Sa-Rang Community Church of Southern California will not cease missions.
